Santa Fe, NM – Baseball fans can celebrate Mother's Day with Isotopes mascot "Orbit" and fresh, fast, affordable food in a family restaurant. Bumble Bee's Baja Grill is opening of a fourth location this weekend and Orbit will be making an appearance at the new Albuquerque restaurant from 1:30 to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

With two successful restaurants in Santa Fe and one in Albuquerque at San Mateo and Montgomery, the new store is located at 3423 Central Avenue on Nob Hill. A grand opening is planned for a date to be announced.

The restaurant décor is bright and festive, casual, family-friendly, and perfect for family celebrations. Also, Bumble Bee's will celebrate the Isotopes on Bumble Bee's Baja Grill Day at Isotopes Park, Thursday, May 18.

The rotisserie chicken is a house specialty and is served rich, golden brown and juicy. The guacamole -- a measure of freshness in any restaurant -- is flavored with fresh cilantro and lime and made daily. The house salad is another example of Bumble Bee's typically fresh fare -- mixed greens, jicama, avocado and cotija cheese, tomatoes and tortilla strips with a mild citrus vinaigrette.

Based on the idea of fresh, fast, healthful Mexican food and convenient, casual service, the Santa Fe-based chain has won the title of the Santa Fe Reporter's "Best Restaurant" all three years of its operation.
